Summary:

Bob's musical journey began at a very early age with a passion for guitar. When playing clubs, Bob likes to switch over to an 8 ohm Eden 410T cabinet that is rear ported for the deep bass that really gets folks out of their chairs.

Bob is still playing his dependable Alvarez 5 string equipped with passive Bartolini PJ pickups and his MusicMan 4 string sunburst fretless rigged with Seymour Duncan active electronics. This year he began to move into a new level of playing when he picked up a Stagg Electric Upright Bass.
